



The procedural steps for the official P.R.E Stud Book INSCRIPTION of FOALS in the United States and Canada as mandated by the Spanish Ministry of Agriculture through LG-ANCCE are as follows:

Step 1. Breeder Code

The Inscription service Applicant/Foal Owner must be in the possession of a valid Breeder Codigo issued by the Spanish Stud Book as previously managed by the Spanish Ministry of Defense (Cria Caballar) and currently by the Spanish Ministry of Agriculture (LG-ANCCE). An Owner Code may not request for Stud Book services.

Step 2. Complete an LG Application for Service

This service application lists all the various services that Breeders can request for P.R.E. horses that are recorded in the LG Stud Book in their names at the moment of application submission.

The application for Inscription must be completed and submitted by the foal Owner, who, should he/she not coincide with the name of the broodmare Owner, must provide valid proof of ownership of the foal being registered, plus the original Breeding Certificate, which should have been supplied at the time of the purchase. The Breeder name appearing in the documents and on the Inscription will be the Owner of the broodmare at the time of birth.

When completing the LG Application for Service, it is extremely critical that Breeders fill in ALL of the sections without exception. The Service Code for Incriptions is 103 .

Step 3. Submitting the Application for Service

Send the completed Inscription documents to the LG-ANCCE Stud Book affiliate office in Wellington, Florida . Please note that you must send all the correct and complete information relating to the Inscriptions that have been requested to the Stud Book processing center. In other words you will send (via mail or scan email) us the originals of the Correctly completed applications for service, together with a photocopy of each breeding certificate to the following address:
